## Dormouse Class to Shrewsbury

Shrewsbury Museum are running a Peter Rabbit Exhibition and story workshop for schools in May and June. As this is an important part of our work in 'Understanding the World' we would like to take the children in Dormouse Class to this experience. Following the workshop, we will walk up to the Quarry for lunch and a short play session in the play area.

We intend to leave school at about 9.15 and return by about 2.30 on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June. The children will travel by coach accompanied by at least 5 adults - Mrs Watts, Mrs Billington, Miss Parry, Mrs Kenning and Miss Thomas. All children in Nursery are invited to come along, even if they are not normally in school on a Tuesday.

The workshop and coach cost  $\pounds$ 220, so for each child we are asking for a voluntary contribution of  $\pounds$ 9.50. We are grateful to FOCS for funding 50% of our coach costs – without this support we would have to be asking for  $\pounds$ 14.50. If enough funds are not received, however, we may still have to cancel the visit.

The children will need to wear uniform (if Reception/Y1), comfy shoes and bring a lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Lunches can be ordered from our kitchen. These must, by law, be preordered. We are unable to provide a lunch on the day – if anyone does forget their lunch we will have to contact parents and, if unsuccessful, they will have to stay in school and order a cooked lunch. For those in Reception and Year 1, the lunches are free under the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme.
