

SCHOOL SPIDER APP - ABSENCE REPORTING



You can now report any child absences by logging into the website on the downloaded App or via the desktop website. A few parents have already used

this and found it quite easy to use. An absence report that has been 'accepted' does not mean the absence has been authorised.

Currently, 35% of parents are using the App. It's free and easy to use.
