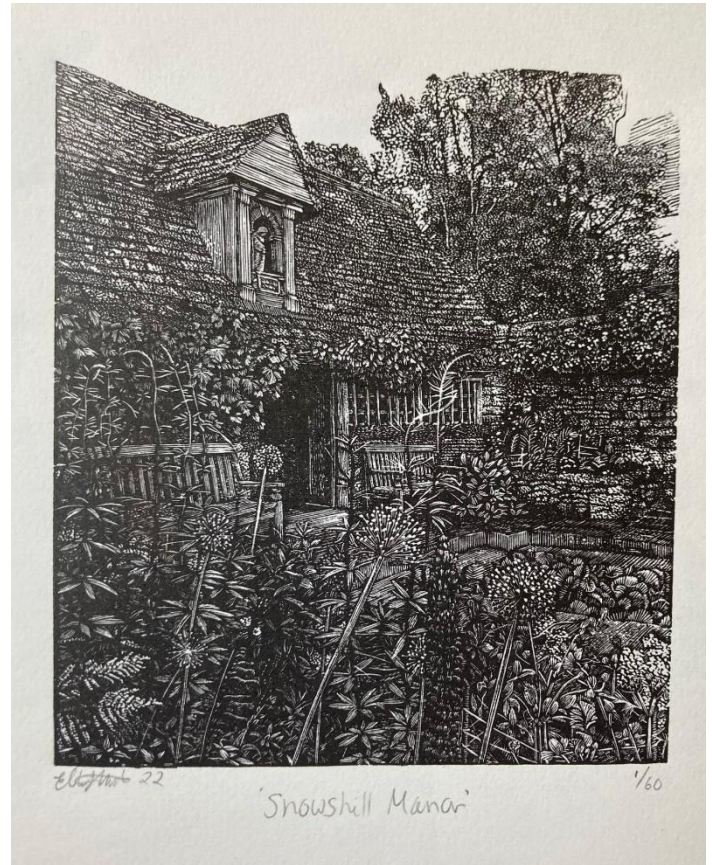
STAR CHILDREN
