**Dyslexia** is a specific learning difficulty that mainly causes issues with certain abilities used for reading, writing and/or spelling. It's estimated that up to 1 in every 10 people has some degree of dyslexia. It is a lifelong issue that can present challenges on a daily basis, but support is available to improve reading and writing skills.
