We adopt a zero-debt policy for dinner money. Please ensure that your child(ren)'s dinner account is regularly topped up. Nursery dinners cost £1.75 a day (£8.75pw) and dinners for Y3-6 cost £2.45 a day (£12.25pw). Large debts may mean that we are unable to serve a hot meal until the debt is cleared.

From September, meal charges will rise to £2.55 for Y3-6 and £1.85 for Nursery.
