Next committee meeting: Thursday 18th September at 8pm, kindly hosted by the Reece's (at Acton Reynald). Everyone welcome to attend.


Heroes of The Hill - this 5k and 10k event has been postponed and will be rescheduled for Spring 2026. More info to follow.
